Goals for 2023.

- -Triple the number of people served.
- -Grow the available resources for scholarships
- -Purchase equipment for summer and winter sports
- -Train partner organizations to work with athletes with disabilities

In 2023 Valley Adaptive Sports provided free of charge:

- 83 individuals served in 2024. Up from 24 in 2023. Up 345%
- 24 sled hockey sessions between Victor, ID and Idaho Falls, ID
- 23 cycling lessons
- 42 ski lessons scholarships (JHMR, GTR)
- 2 spinal cord injury camps in a supporting role
- 48 swimming lessons
- 8 rock climbing lessons
- 2 Wraptor Nordic Xc skis purchased (arriving December 2023)
- 37 Adaptive cyclist at Wydaho Festival
